Meet Willow | Age 4 | Conway, MO

When Willow was just 14 months old, her parents knew something wasn't right. She wasn't meeting developmental milestones like other children her age. She couldn't speak or hold a spoon, and her behavior had begun to change in ways that were both confusing and concerning. After a visit with her primary care physician, Willow was referred to speech and occupational therapy, where she was diagnosed with Level 3 Autism.

Willow's diagnosis brings daily challenges. She struggles to understand danger and doesn't recognize what could harm her, making even simple moments feel overwhelming. Sensory overload, frequent illness, and constant supervision are part of everyday life for Willow and her family. Nights were especially difficult. Willow often eloped from her bed, unaware of the risks, which raised safety concerns and made rest difficult for her parents.

"CMN blessed us with a safety sleeper bed for Willow. She elopes most nights, and I wasn't getting any sleep. It was a serious safety concern knowing Willow could roam without understanding the dangers. This bed gave us peace of mind and removed a huge financial burden. Instead of worrying, we can focus on Willow and her needs."

Great News!

CoxHealth and **St. Louis Children's Hospital** — with the support and expertise of pediatric specialists at Washington University School of Medicine — will work collaboratively to bring more advanced care to children and families in Springfield, MO, and the surrounding region, reducing the need for families to travel long distances for specialty care.

Initial efforts will focus on significantly expanding pediatric inpatient care by creating a new pediatric hospital within the walls of **CoxHealth**, which will allow for close collaboration with WashU Medicine clinicians and **St. Louis Children's Hospital** caregivers and the construction of a comprehensive 133,000 square foot outpatient center, which will be the region's largest pediatric outpatient center for Southwest Missouri. The new facility will include ambulatory surgery, pediatric, primary and specialty care clinics, and urgent care, as well as imaging, therapy, sleep studies, laboratory services, pharmacy and infusion. Together, these enhancements will increase local access to more highly specialized medical and surgical care.

By working together, **St. Louis Children's Hospital** and **CoxHealth** will advance pediatric care in southwest Missouri through the following key initiatives:

Improved Access:

A standalone, dedicated pediatric outpatient center with ambulatory surgery and specialty pediatric clinics will allow families to stay close to home and reduce the need to travel long distances to seek care.

Advanced Care:

Our region's pediatric specialty and NICU inpatient care will be enhanced through closer collaboration with WashU Medicine clinicians and St. Louis Children's Hospital.

2025 was a record year!

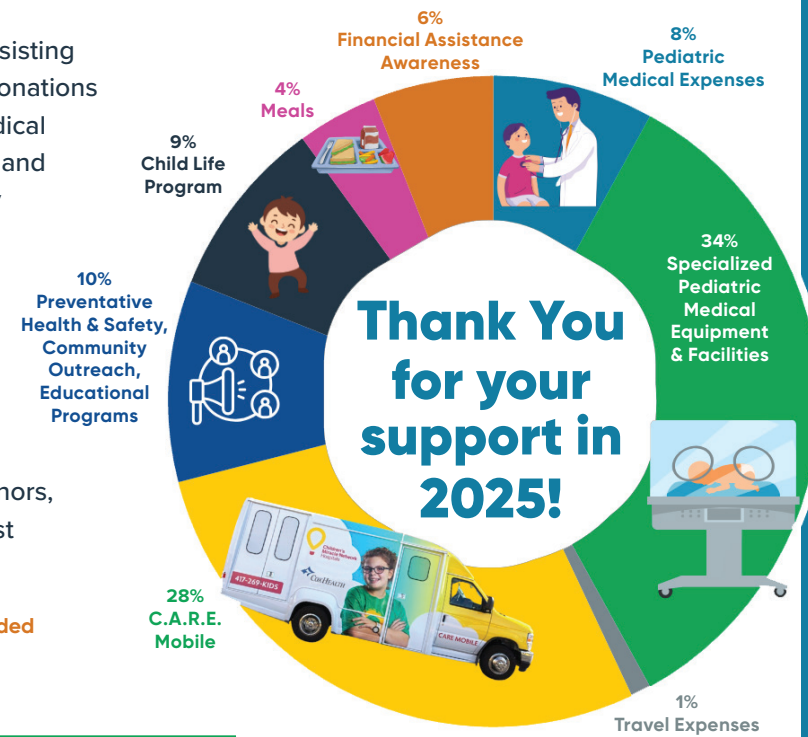
Together, we raised **\$3,247,605** to help support children in our community.
